

Placement for female counsellors

Woman's Trust is a BACP accredited person-centred/humanistic counselling service for women affected by domestic abuse

You need to:

- be at least in the final year of a course in Person-Centred/Humanistic/Integrative counselling or psychotherapy.
- have a minimum of 50 client hours.
- provide a certificate of proficiency or competency from your training body that evidences that you have been assessed as safe to practice with clients.
- have been or are currently in long-term personal therapy.
- be able to work with clients face-to-face and remotely via telephone and/or a secure platform such as Zoom or Microsoft Teams

Woman's Trust offers:

- Free fortnightly supervision in groups of up to 4 counsellors for 2 hours.
- Reimbursement of telephone and travel expenses.
- Access to a CPD programme.
- Option to work in **west** or **east London**.
- Work with four clients (from a wide range of cultures and backgrounds) per week for a maximum of 18 sessions.

If successful you must attend a two-day training course. The dates for this will be confirmed after the selection process.

All placements are for female counsellors. The Equality Action 2010 pursuant to Schedule 9, Part 1 applies.
